■ **About the proposal**

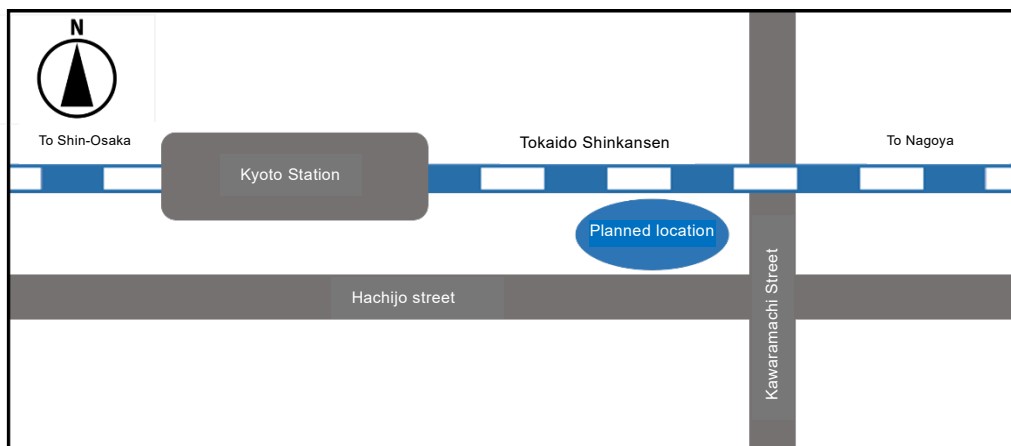
Concept	Within an approximately 45 meter high building (8 stories above the ground) constructed under the Urban Planning Proposal System, a complex hub will be developed where commercial facilities and business offices will be located. To accelerate the development and growth of the city, we will create new value such as a bustling town and creative business hub.	
Overview	In addition to the office area that will house our head office functions, the office complex will feature bustling spaces and spaces for conversation and interaction on the lower floors.	
	First floor	Bustling spaces (community plaza, multipurpose space, cafe, and supermarket)
	Second and third floors	Conversation and interaction spaces (various meeting rooms, and a large hall)

	Fourth floor	Nippon Electric Glass main entrance Co-creation space (exhibition and interaction space)
	Fifth to eighth floors	Nippon Electric Glass offices
